About Marwen

Marwen's mission is to educate and inspire young people from under-resourced communities and schools through the visual arts. Founded in 1987, we work with approximately 900 Chicago students in grades 6-12 each year, providing rigorous, high-quality programs in visual art, college counseling and portfolio support, and career exploration opportunities – entirely free of charge. All of our programs take place at our 8-studio facility in Chicago's River North neighborhood. Our studios, supplies, gallery spaces, and professional teaching artists provide resources that most of our students would not be able to access otherwise in their schools or communities. Because research shows that arts participation can have a profound impact among economically and socially disadvantaged young people, we extend significant outreach efforts across the city and draw students from nearly all of Chicago's 57 zip codes (287 different schools and 53 zip codes in 2017).

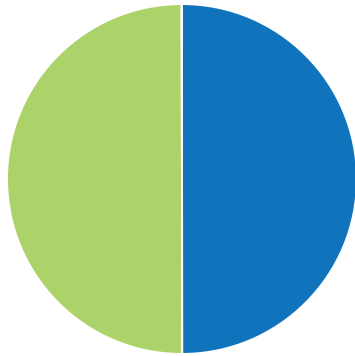

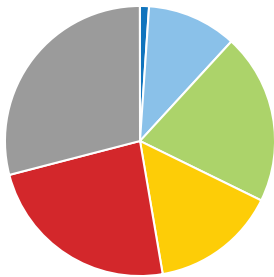

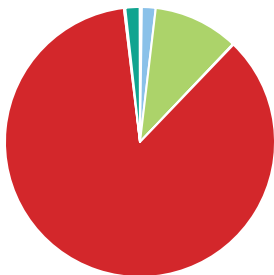
