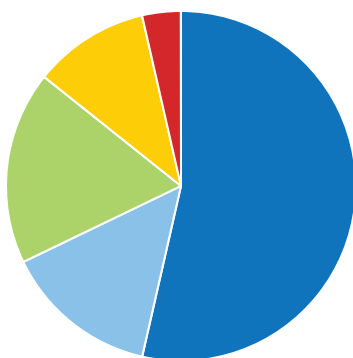

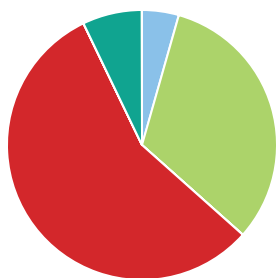

| Blues Workshop | The Foundations Of Music Blues Workshop provides classroom teachers with a collection of education materials, including a Powerpoint Presentation, worksheets, discussion topics and a short quiz to familiarize students with the Blues as an art form. Students learn about topics such as the Great Northern Migration, Blues instruments and important Blues artists. The workshop culminates with a compelling, live performance presented by Living Legends of Chicago Blues. | Performance / Workshop, Other |
| General Music/Choir | Foundations of Music has developed a 32-week curriculum for General Music/Choir that is designed for CPS elementary students. Our mission is to provide all of our classes in-school time so all students have ease of access. This course fulfills the objectives of the Illinois and National Standards of Music Education, and explores the fundamentals of music theory, vocal technique, singing alone and in groups, playing rhythmic instruments, listening and analysis and discussions of music and cultures. | Residency, Out-of-School and/or Summer, Field Trip |
| Jazz Workshop | Similar to our Blues Workshop, the Foundations of Music Jazz Workshop is focused on providing students with an overview of Jazz music including ties to Chicago, history, society and students' own lives. The program includes a ready-to-teach flexible curriculum complete with materials for classroom teachers to implement, and culminates in a assembly style live, interactive performance by a Jazz Band! | Performance / Workshop |
| Songwriting/Production | The Foundations of Music Songwriting/Production program is a unique course that introduces students to songwriting and music production using industry standard equipment. Each student is encouraged to use his or her talents to contribute to the class. Students write lyrics, design back beats and record songs working as a collaborative group. | Residency, Performance / Workshop, Out-of-School and/or Summer, Field Trip |
